



SA CABANA CHARDONNAY 2021 RECOGNIZED WITH A BACCHUS D'OR

The Spanish Tasters Union has awarded the Gold Medal to this single varietal wine from Bodega Sa Cabana (Binissalem, Mallorca), which is owned by the Codolá Bonet family (Valentin Hotel Group) and belongs to the D.O. (IGP) Vino de la Tierra Mallorca.



Sa Cabana Chardonnay 2021 has been recognized with a Gold Medal at the XXI Bacchus 2023 International Competition, organized by the Spanish Tasters Union.

May 23rd, 2023. Bodega Sa Cabana is in luck. Its single-varietal Chardonnay 2021 has been recognized with a Gold Medal at the XXI Bacchus 2023 International Competition, organized every year by the Spanish Tasters Union.

This important award confirms the consolidation of a project that was born 6 years ago. Today, thanks to the excellent care of its vineyards and the innovative winemaking processes applied by the team currently in charge, Bodega Sa Cabana has managed to make a name for itself in the increasingly competitive world of Mallorcan wine.

Produced in the island's main wine-producing locality, Binissalem, Sa Cabana's Chardonnay 2021 belongs to the D.O. (I.G.P.) Vino de la Tierra Mallorca.

Tasting notes:

Visual phase: straw yellow color, with hints of new gold, clean and bright.

Olfactory phase: pronounced intensity, first aromas of tropical fruits such as pineapple or mango. Reminiscences of citrus fruit also overturned in a tropical freshness.

Tasting phase: dry and refreshing entry in the mouth, again aromas of tropical fruit, pineapple and mango. Citrus hints such as grapefruit return and add freshness.

The lees work provides an unctuous texture, highlighting the aromas and flavors already present in the wine, making it a very elegant wine.



About Bodega Sa Cabana:

Sa Cabana is an old agricultural estate located in Binissalen (Mallorca), owned by the Codolá Bonet family, historically linked to the agricultural sector of the island. In its beginnings it was dedicated to dairy farming, and later to the traditional polyculture of Mallorca, based on citrus fruits, olive trees, almond trees, carob trees and cereals.

It occupies an area of 35 hectares, of which 11 were destined 22 years ago to the cultivation of vines of Mallorcan (Giró Ros and Callet) and European (Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Syrah and Chardonnay) varieties.

Six years ago, the extraordinary quality of the grapes led the owners to open a winery to produce their own wines in a professional manner.

Currently the Bodega Sa Cabana has ONE TEAM, and stands out for the extraordinary quality of its grapes, which are cared for with the utmost care, and in a sustainable manner, in order to achieve high quality wines.

It produces 3 red wines (S'Alegria -Manto Negro 100%- , Viure -Callet 100%- and Merlot -aged in French oak barrels of 500L; 3 white wines (Giró Ros, Chardonnay in tank- and Xisca -Giró Ros aged in barrels of 500L and 2 rosé wines (Rosé Merlot and Rosé Cabernet).
